

What is Payroll Giving?

Payroll Giving is one of the easiest, most tax effective ways of helping the patients of Great Ormond Street Hospital get better.

A donation made in this way is taken from your gross pay. This means that for every £10 you give it will only cost you £8 (£6 if you pay the higher tax rate), therefore it is effectively costing you less to give.

Why should I give to Great Ormond Street Hospital?

Great Ormond Street Hospital treats many thousands of patients each year - children who are suffering from the rarest, most complex and often life-threatening conditions. The hospital is a great place of hope for our patients and their families and whilst the NHS funds our day to day core activity, we need extra resources to deliver world class clinical care, research and staff training.

Payroll Giving provides a regular income which allows us to plan for the acquisition of equipment, the funding of research projects, and the ambitious redevelopment program the hospital is undergoing. Our hospital is over 150 years old, many of our patients are treated in conditions which are crowded, uncomfortable, lacking in privacy and falling short of what they deserve. You can help us to change this.

How much should I give?

You can give as much or as little as you like, even the smallest amount would grow over time to enable us to buy vital medical equipment, support families and fund our redevelopment:

- £5 could buy special neonatal masks, small and delicate enough to fit a new born baby's face.
- £25 could help towards funding our research programmes which investigate children's illnesses
 to find future cures.
- £40 could help towards the cost of a specially-designed bed to make a child much more comfortable.
- £100 could buy four toys specially adapted for the children to help with their rehabilitation.
