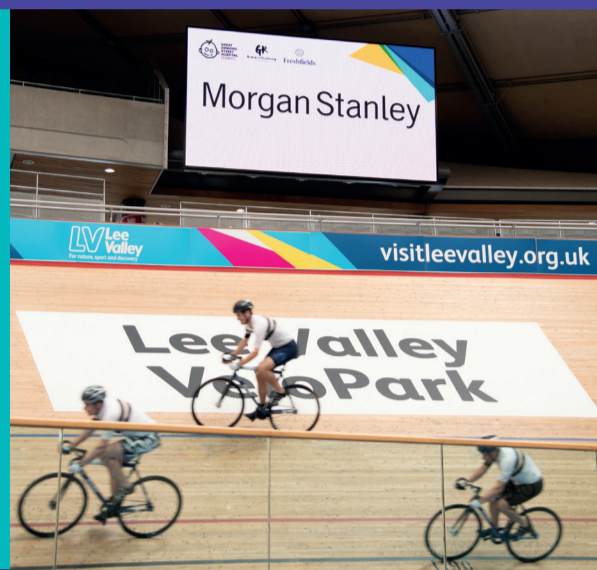
THE VELODROME CHALLENGE

SHYLA'S STORY

Now more than ever, children and young people with cancer need your support. For children like Shyla, research into new, promising treatments is vital. Shyla was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia in February 2020 and referred to GOSH, where she started several rounds of chemotherapy. However, after relapsing in December 2021, she was referred to the CAR-T cell therapy headed by Professor Persis Amrolia.

After rounds of CAR-T cell therapy to battle the cancer and other infections, she was able to go home in the summer of 2022. Without the new ground-breaking CAR-T cell therapy, her mum Molly says, "I think it was a combination of the anti-viral drugs and the CAR-T cells that made the difference. I think if there's not research, then you can't progress any further. It literally saved Shyla's life."
