There is a small amount of legal stuff that we have to make you aware of when you tick the Gift Aid box.
If you pay UK income tax (this includes tax on your savings, pension or capital gains tax) and this is more than the amount GOSHCC, and any other charity/Community Amateur Sports Club will claim in the tax year (6 April-5 April) then you can gift aid your donations. (Council tax and VAT don't count). Please note that collective donations made via an individual cannot be gift aided.
